




#### **Answer Keys**

"Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

And He spoke a <u>parable</u> to them: "Can the <u>blind</u> lead the blind? Will they not both <u>fall</u> into the <u>ditch</u>? A disciple is not above his <u>teacher</u>, but everyone who is <u>perfectly</u> trained will be like his teacher. And why do you look at the <u>speck</u> in your brother's <u>eye</u>, but do not perceive the <u>plank</u> in your own eye? Or how can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me <u>remove</u> the speck that is in your eye,' when you <u>yourself</u> do not <u>see</u> the plank that is in your own eye? <u>Hypocrite</u>! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see <u>clearly</u> to remove the speck that is in your brother's eye."

"For a good tree does not bear bad <u>fruit</u>, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. For every tree is <u>known</u> by its own fruit. For men do not gather figs from <u>thorns</u>, nor do they gather <u>grapes</u> from a bramble <u>bush</u>. A good man out of the good <u>treasure</u> of his <u>heart</u> brings forth good; and an evil man <u>out</u> of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil. For out of the <u>abundance</u> of the heart his mouth speaks."
