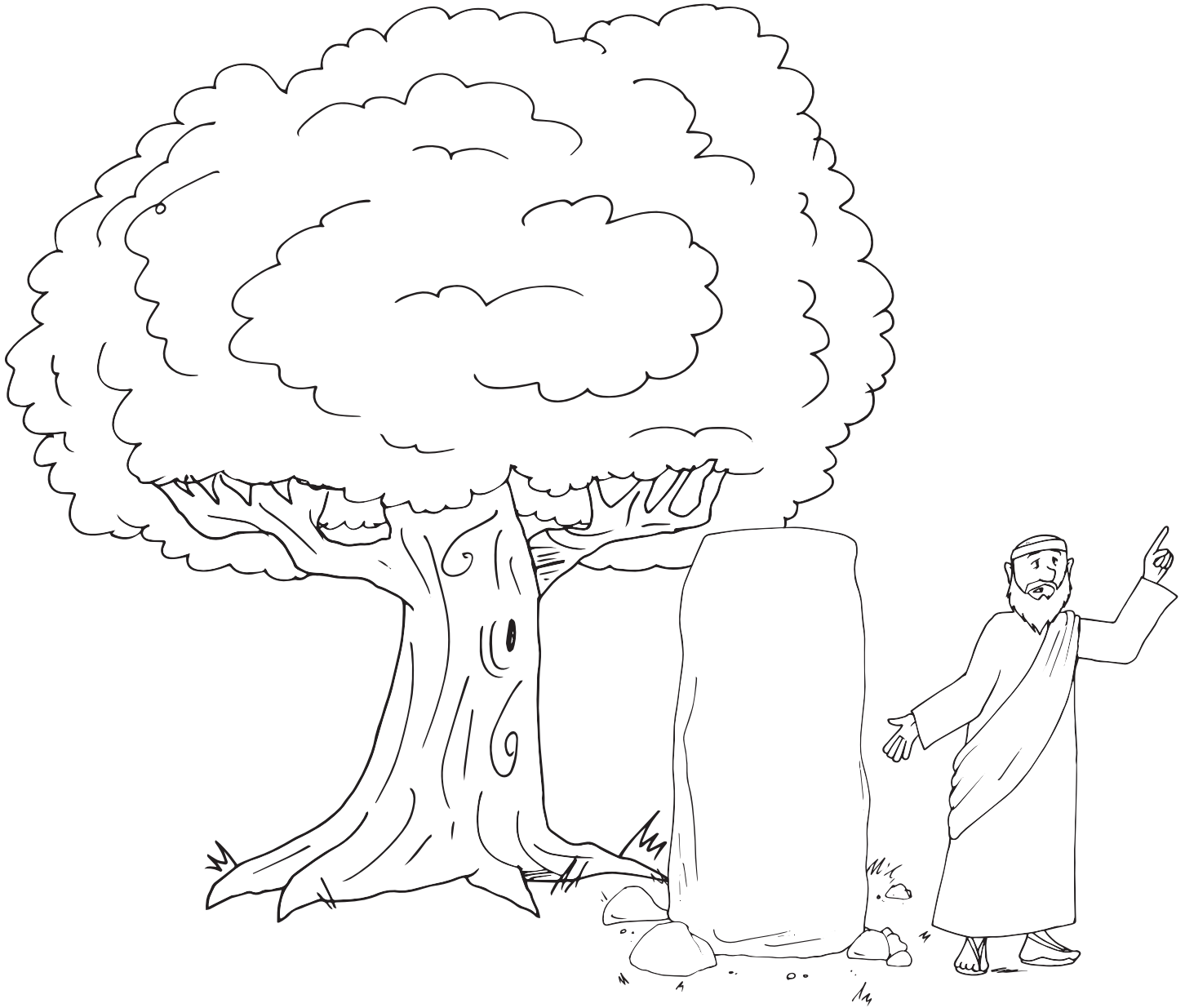

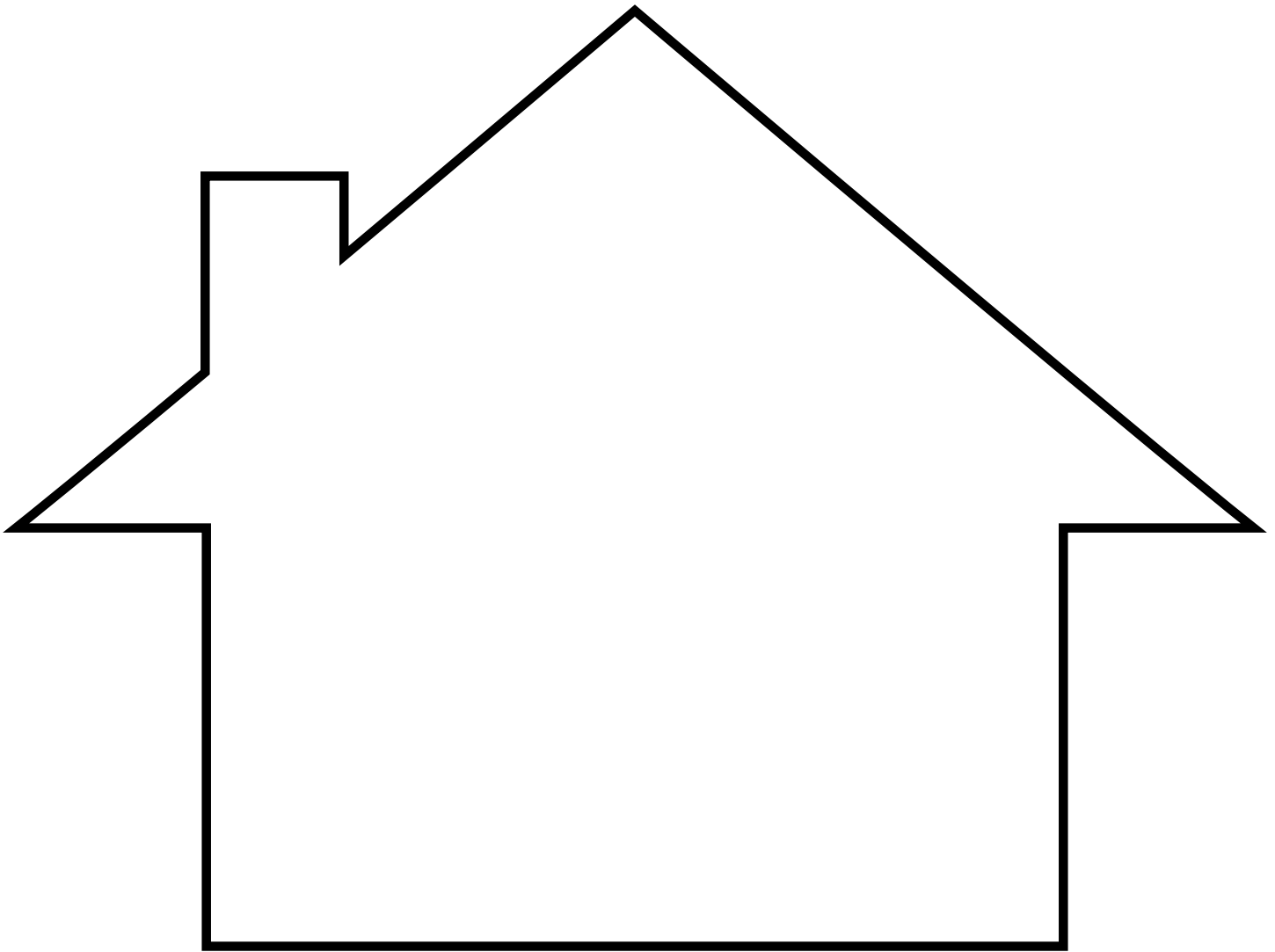

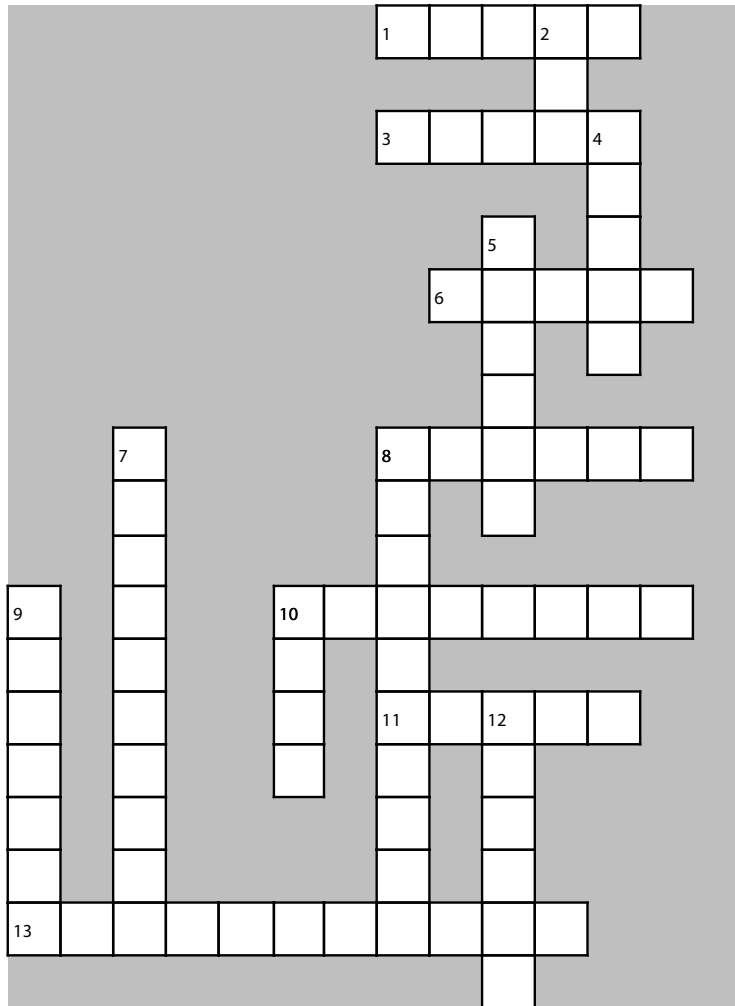

Joshua's Final Instructions Crossword Puzzle

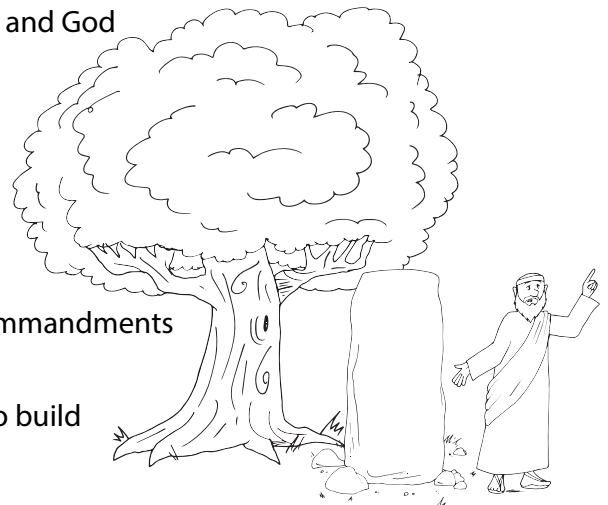

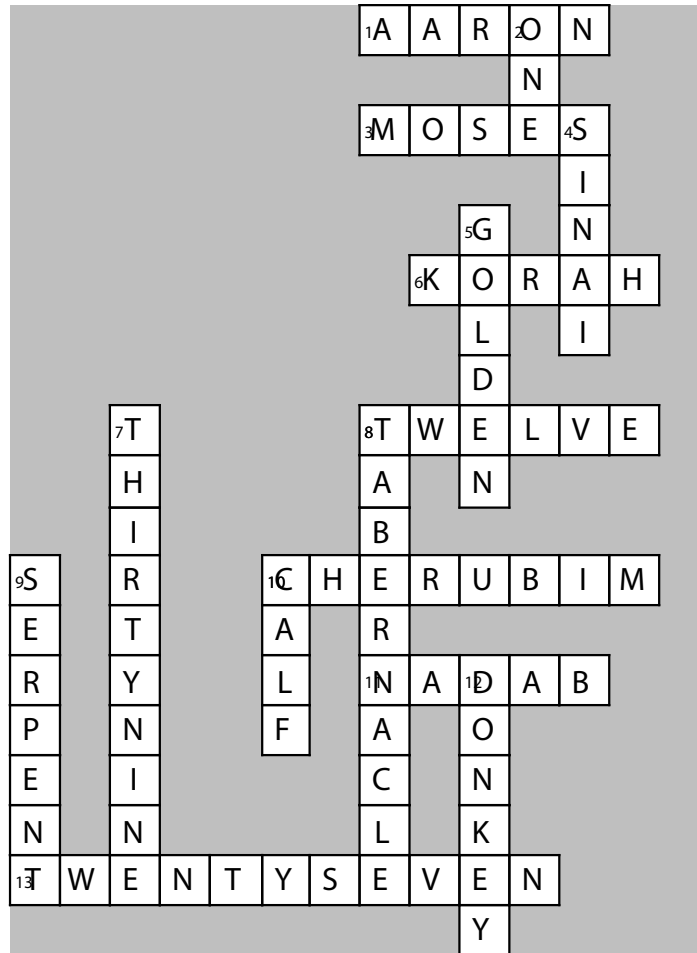
