Apostle means "one sent."


The apostles also is served others who heeded help, and they healed the sick to prove that their message was from God.

(Matthew 28:18).










The apostles went went everywhere teaching who would listen.


The apostles preached to soldiers, slaves, jailers, kings and governors.

Two apostles (John, Peter) wrote books of the New Testament which were **letters** (epistles) to churches or individuals.










