What About Thomas Code Activity

Jesus planned to go to Bethany in Juda because **Lazarus** was dying. Most of the disciples were **afraid**, But **Thomas** said, "Let us go with Him that we may **die** with Him" (John 11:16) After Jesus' resurrection, He appeared to the apostles, but Thomas was not there. When the eleven apostles told him they had seen Jesus, he said, "Unless I see in His hands the print of the **nails**, and put my hand into His **side**, I will not **believe**" (John 20:25). Eight days later, Jesus appeared again so that Thomas could see Him for Himself. Jesus said to him, "Thomas, because you have **seen** Me, you have **believed**. Blessed are those who have **not seen** and yet have **believed**" (John 20:29). Thomas had a faith problem. Hebrews 11:6 tells us that "without **faith** it is **impossible** to please God."
